Unfortunately, there have been many recent instances of unapproved tree removal within our community. While the Association makes every effort to accommodate homeowner requests, there are instances in which it is not appropriate to approve the removal of trees. Trees provide aesthetic appeal to our community, provide necessary buffers between properties in many instances, play an important visual role in streetscapes, and oftentimes play an integral role in the overall landscaping of a Lot. As a reminder, the Towne Lake Hills Community Association fine policy for unapproved tree removal is as follows:

Any homeowner who removes, or allows to be removed, trees without obtaining pre-approval by from the Towne Lake Hills Architectural Control Committee per Article VII Section 13 of the Declaration of Protective Covenants, will be subject to an immediate \$250.00 fine. Further, the Association, in certain instances, may assess additional fines in excess of the \$250.00 initial fine based on the nature of the violation, in addition to possible remediation (installation of new trees) and all other enforcement remedies afforded the Association by Article XV of the Protective Covenants.

- Both door and flag must be present, in good condition.
- Mailbox needs to be clean and free from debris left by perching birds, mildew and faded paint.


Dog Barking is a Nuisance!



- For all types of grass, spread lime on your lawn if you haven't done so in more than a year. A soil test will specifically let you know how much you need, but as a general rule, 40 pounds covers an area of 1000 square feet.
- Sharpen your mower blades to prevent shredding leaves once the lawn needs mowing. A clean cut will lessen the probability of disease once the weather warms.
- Apply organic fertilizers or compost if that your preferred technique now so that it can begin breaking down and have nutrients available to roots when the grass starts growing.

Cool Season Grasses (Fescue, Kentucky Bluegrass)

• If you are planting cool season grasses, make sure not to use a pre-emergent for six weeks after seeding.

- For established lawns, apply pre-emergent combined with fertilizer to prevent the broadleaf weeds from sprouting and setting seed once the weather warms up.
- Apply chemical fertilizer for the final time until the fall.
 Most cool season grasses are in their dormant phase once the weather heats up.

Warm Season Grasses (Bermuda grass, Centipede, St. Augustine):

- Apply pre-emergent now if you are planning on seeding in the spring. This will give time for the pre-emergent to work without preventing your grass seed from sprouting later on. No need to apply one with a fertilizer at this time, as the dormant turf will not benefit from it.
- If you are seeing green grass this early in the season in your warm-season variety, it is probably bluegrass. To keep an even texture in your lawn, dig it out before it spreads.

Spring Yard Clean-up List

Spring is almost here, we all want to be outside enjoying the great weather and not taking care of the yard. All yards will need some TLC after the winter season. If you take time now, you can prevent problems in the future. Make a checklist of what needs to be done, take a weekend and get ready to enjoy your yard.

- Prune back overgrown shrubs, trees and ornamental grasses; except for those which bloom in early spring such as Azaleas & Camellias as you will cut off all the flower buds
- Lawns Weeds: Pull/Treat weeds
- Lawn Fertilization / Pre-emergent: Fertilize Fescue lawns now, Bermuda/Zoysia yards once they turn 50% green. Apply Pre-emergent to all lawns to prevent crabgrass & annual weeds
- Plant cool season vegetables such as lettuce, broccoli, spinach & cauliflower as well as berry bushes and fruit trees. Start seeds of warm season vegetables and flowers indoors.
- Inspect the sprinkler system
- Clean out gutters
- Clean up debris/leaves
- Mulch/Pine Straw

- Paint /repair your mailbox if needed
- Power wash mildew / dirt from your home, driveway and sidewalks
- Prepare planters
- · Sit Back and Enjoy!

Remember the Birds

- Clean out bird houses and bird baths so they are ready to welcome new residents.
- Keep Feeding. Be sure to keep feeders full to attract and keep birds in your yard.





Registration has been set for Sunday, March 19 from 2:00pm-4:00pm in the clubhouse.


We will be doing swim suit fittings at registration so make sure to bring your swimmer(s) with you.



How to Add Lobs to Your Tennis Practice Session

You need to practice lobs with tennis practice drills that simulates a real point. The best tennis drills should have you practice using your lob to get yourself out of trouble when you are out of position or win the point when the other player is at the net.

For example, have the other player stand half way between the service line and the net and feed a ball to you. You can practice just hitting a lob that the other player cannot hit as an overhead. The lob should be very high and deep. The player at the net can also feed the ball out wide, and you practice hitting a lob on the run that is again high and deep.

Another option is for the player feeding the ball to stand at the baseline because there are times that you are going to want to lob when the other player is back there as well. Do the same thing and have the player feed a ball to you down the middle and then a few out wide. Lob the ball back, and practice making the lob tough for the other player to handle.

Next, you can stand at the net and have the other player lob over your head, so you can practice running towards the back fence and hitting a lob back that keeps you in the point without the other player being able to hit an easy overhead.


